- **Training:** a fruitful and dynamic professional development course which will enhance educators' skills, improve the support they provide to their students and promote the social inclusion of students with learning disorders.
- **Pilot Training:** Mons held the Pilot Training with the JSTE, the Joint Staff Training Event, that was a crucial step of the path of exchange of good practices and mutual sharing of the experiences and knowledge among the professionals involved in these activities.
